The 15th anniversary of our theatre is coming up!

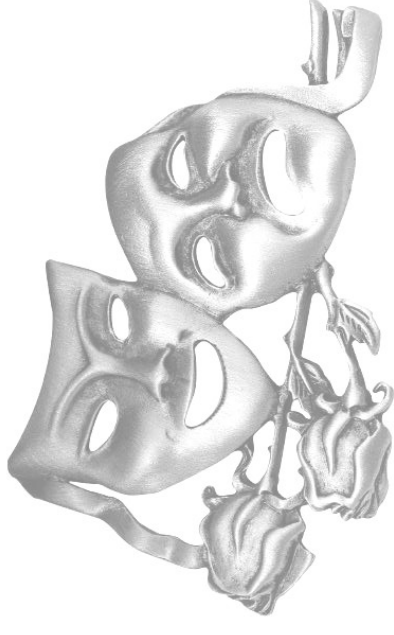
