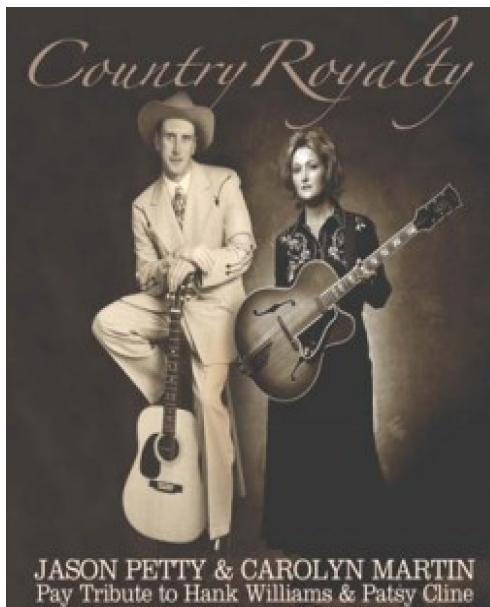
"SEE THE WORLD FROM A TO Z"

SEPT. 30TH- OCTOBER 9TH

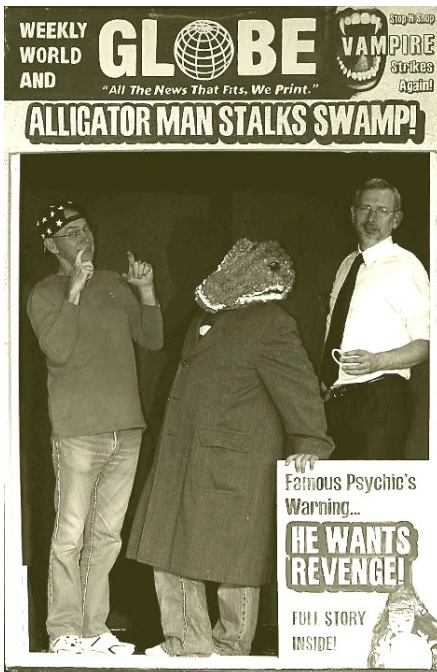
DUCK HUNTER SHOOTS ANGEL is the uproarious story of two bumbling brothers who have never shot a duck but think they shot an angel. As they lament their fates in a murky swamp, they are chased by a cynical tabloid journalist and his reluctant photographer, who don't believe any of it—until feathers, wings and a tiara are discovered along the way. The play hysterically interweaves a love story, sibling rivalry, tawdry media and cultural stereotypes as the chase to find the angel builds to a crescendo in the swamp.

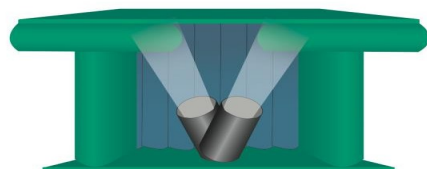

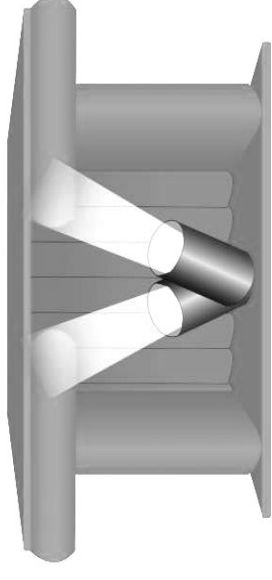
